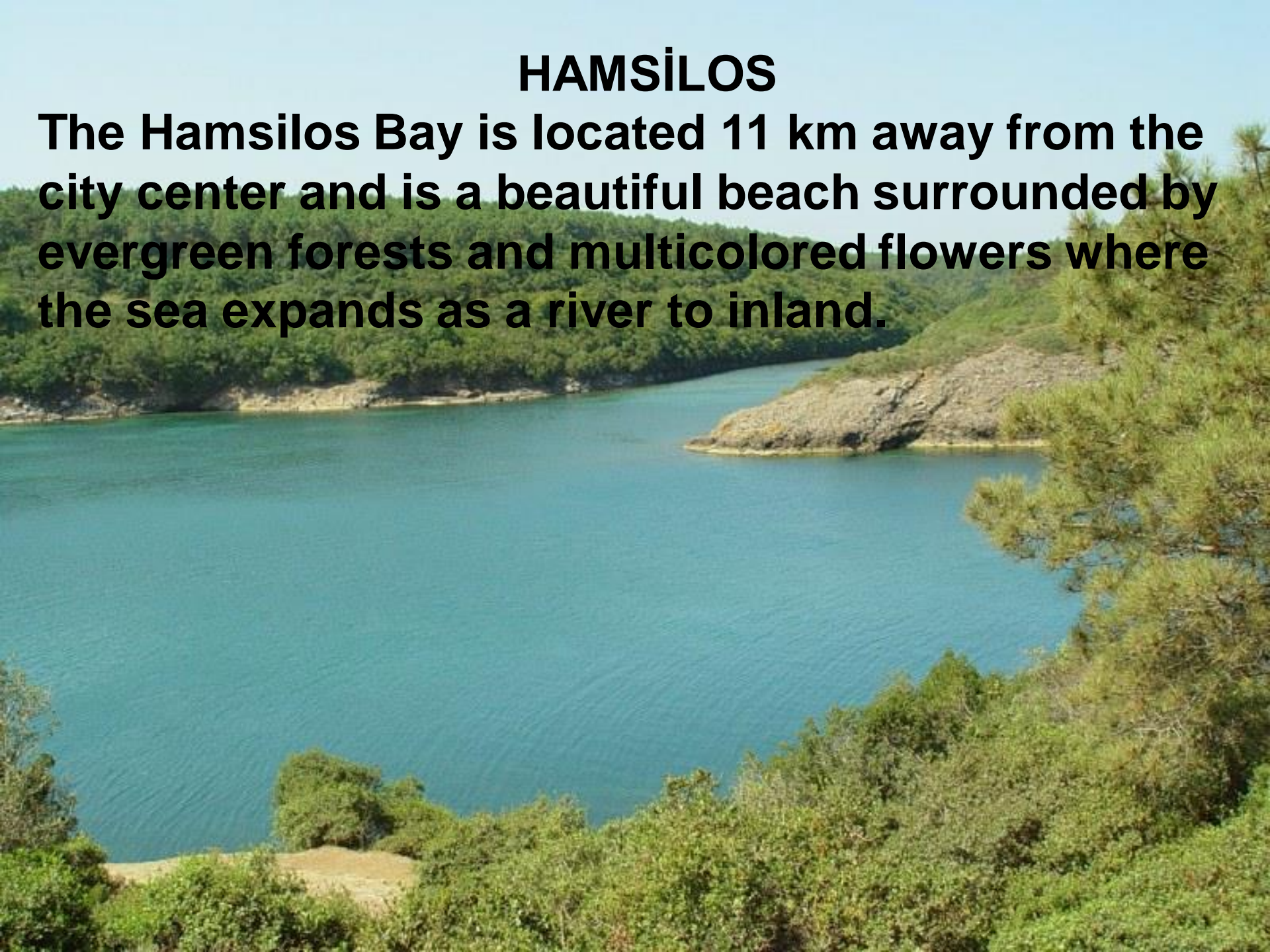






# BEKTAŖAĞA
